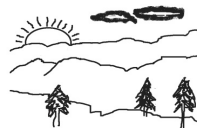

- (2) Write one random word on a blank piece of paper. (Do not write curse words or words referring to sex, sexual acts, anatomical body parts involved in sex, or anything referring to sex, copulation, intercourse, or reproduction.) Opt 1 Only.
- (3) Enclose a small, non-organic object that you have found on one of your runs that either you are not sure what it is and/or you are amazed that you found such a thing. (Do not enclose new or used prophylactics.) Opt 1 Only.
- (4) A check for Option 1: \$30.00, Option 2: \$40.00, Option 3: \$60.00, or Option 4: \$995.00.

This information and material, constituting the "Application", must be received in a timely manner to help with the assessment of the application. One (1) application will be accepted after 6:30PM on October 10th, 2011.
